
# **Security error in eOffice**

eOffice application has been upgraded. You are requested to use Internet Explorer 11 only. Other browsers may not work properly and not recommended.

1. Internet Explorer version 11 required. Check the version of your system's Internet Explorer.




If version is older than 11 log a complaint on 44257, 43698 to update Internet Explorer.

- 2. If eOffice address is saved in favorites, delete the entry from favorites and use the IP address 10.255.233.53 directly in the browser's address box. Once eOffice login screen is opened the address can be saved in favorites.
- 3. Delete the browsing history of the browser. To delete browsing histories go to Internet Options -> Browsing history -> click delete button. Select all options from the next screen and click delete.


## 4. If you are getting the following errors follow the steps given below


Change settings

#### Solution:-

Step-1 Click on the "**change settings**" button. Internet options window will open as given below
